NATURE OF THE DATA

The provision of data is optional.

The refusal to provide the data makes it impossible to perform the intended purposes.

METHOD OF TREATMENT

The processing for the purposes indicated above is carried out on digital support, manually and/or with electronic or, in any case, automated tools.

Access to the data acquired for the aforementioned purposes is permitted to duly authorized personnel.

TRANSFER TO NON-EU COUNTRIES OR INTERNATIONAL ORGANIZATIONS

Personal data will be processed by the Data Controller within the territory of the European Union. If for technical and/or operational reasons it is necessary to use subjects located outside the European Union, or if it is necessary to transfer some of the data collected to technical systems and services managed in the cloud and located outside the of the European Union, the treatment will be regulated in compliance with the provisions of Chapter V of the Regulation and authorized on the basis of specific decisions of the European Union. RIGHTS OF INTERESTED PARTIES

- limitation of the processing of your personal data (in the event of one of the hypotheses indicated in article 18, paragraph 1 of the Regulation), transformation into anonymous form or blocking of data processed in violation of the law, including data which conservation is necessary in relation to the purposes for which the data were collected or subsequently processed.

As an interested party, you also have the right to object in whole or in part:

- for legitimate reasons, to the processing of your personal data, even if pertinent to the purpose of the collection;
- to the processing of personal data concerning you for the sending of communications aimed at promoting initiatives and events of the MOST National Centre.
